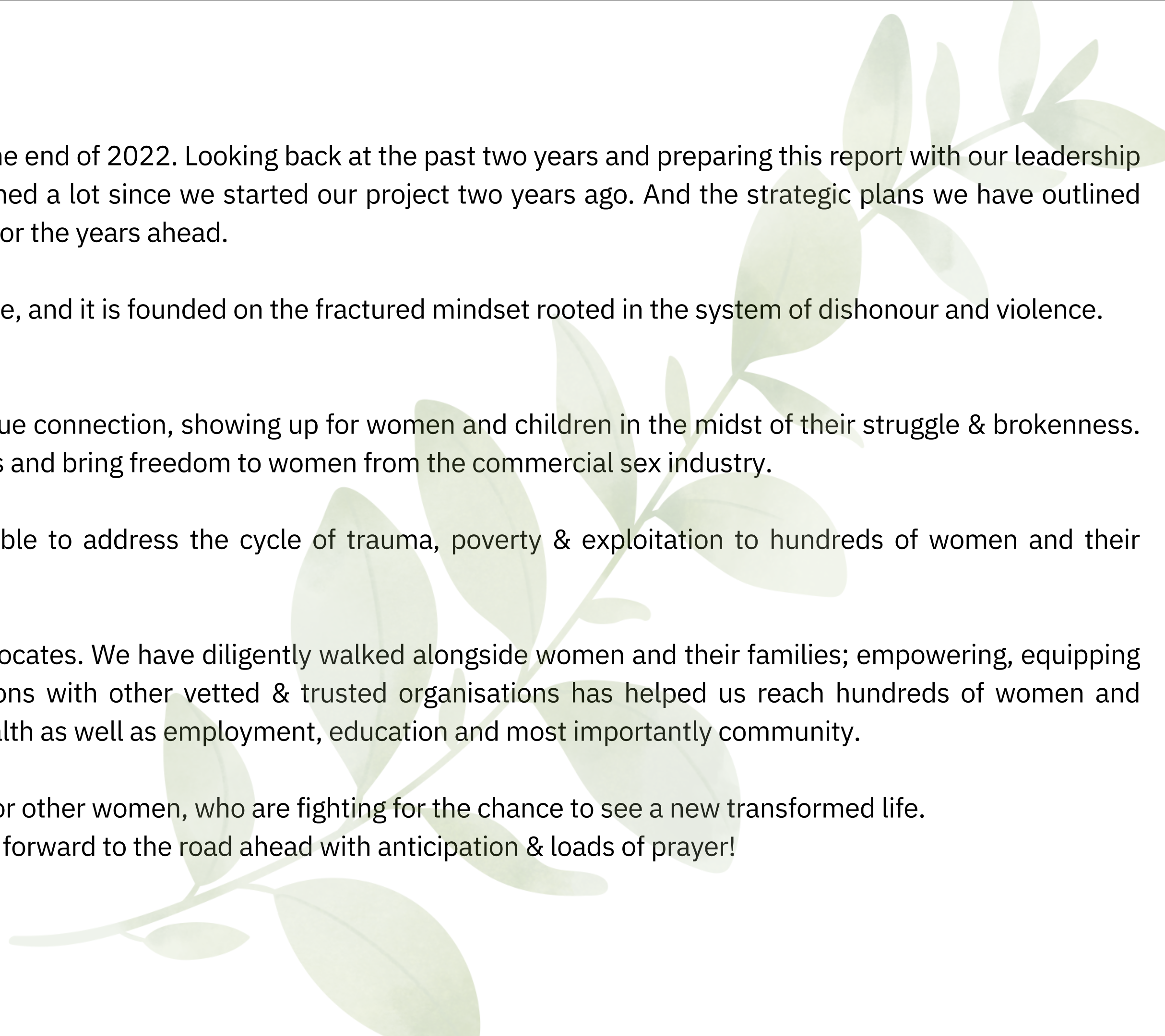

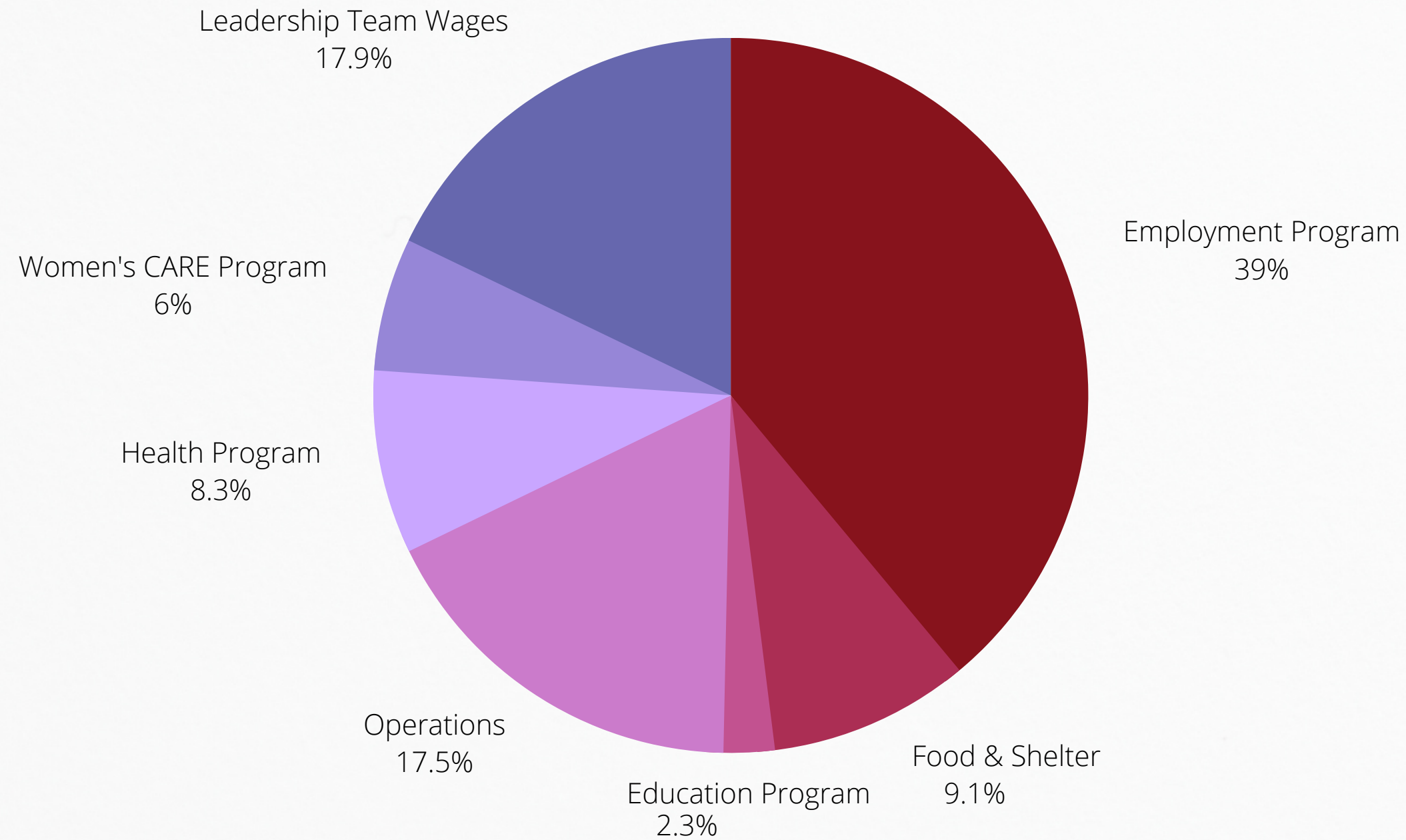

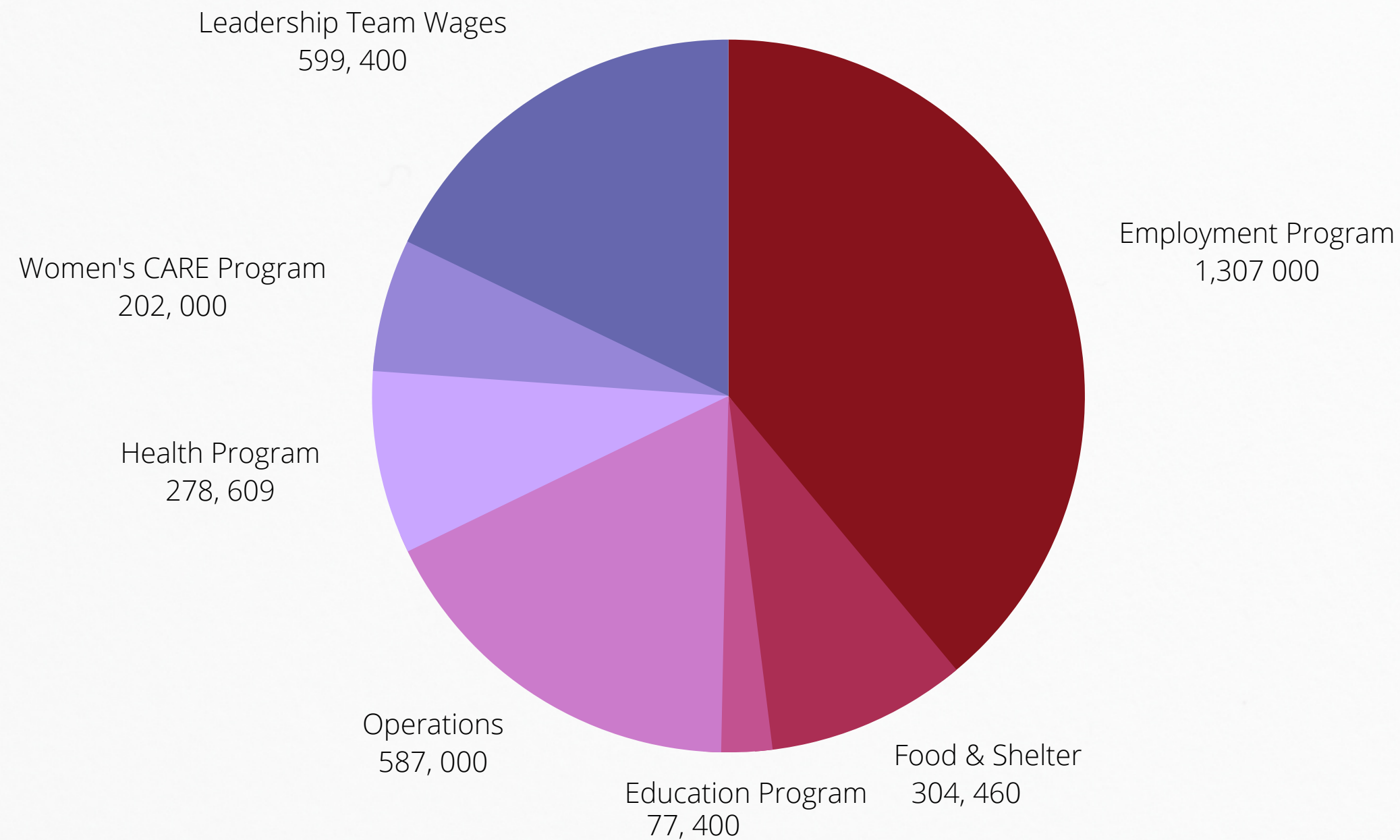

STRATEGIC PLAN 2023 - 2025

What's ahead for us?

We aim to see generational changes.

The past two years helped us see gaps and a greater need to go beyond the lives of the women we serve today.

Empowering communities and setting foundations of preventive measure within the family system is a core goal of our future strategic plan. We aim to see transformation, not only in the lives of women impacted by trauma and exploitation, but in their families and communities.

We aim to bring holistic restoration and address the cycle of poverty & gender-based discrimination within selected communities, in the next few years.

Why?

We recognise that the landscape of human trafficking is complex, and the roots go deep into the cultural system.

There are many contributing factors to exploitation & human trafficking in Thailand. Poverty, broken families, lack of education, migration and spiritual depravity are some of the main causes. These are factors that create a vulnerable society.

Breakdown in family systems is extremely high in Thailand. The 2022 UNICEF report that surveys the global insight on the prospects for children, shows that the two primary institutions for children in their lives which are family and school – has been affected like never before due to Covid 19.

Today's children are the next generation families. Families make a society.

Broken Family Systems

Many of the women we meet, come from a cycle of broken marriages, shattered families, lack of education and poverty.

In Thailand, many family systems are broken by divorce, lack of attachment and healthy family structure. Lack of education, internal migration and spiritual depravity also adds to this dilemma. This increases the number of vulnerable women & children and escalates the risk of human trafficking, exploitation, teen pregnancies and addictions.

FAMILY STRENGTHENING. EDUCATION. TRAUMA. POVERTY.

This is what we plan to address within vulnerable communities for the next few years, as part of our added Preventive Measures Program.


